

- 1. Company Members are **Not Allowed** to respond directly to fire incident scenes in a personal vehicle, unless they have prior authorization. Exemption given to Chief Officers, and EMS Captain.
- 2. Other Fire Line Officers are only allowed to respond to a scene, in the event that no Chief Officer is responding. Example, a Captain may respond directly to the scene of an incident, if no Chief Officer is responding.
- 3. If all apparatus has responded, the member should contact the IC via the station's base radio and inquire if additional manpower is needed.
- 4. Members may respond directly to the scene of EMS calls for "Echo Priority" calls, or when lifting assistance is requested or as approved by the EMS Captain.
