Officer Report's

Chief.

- We have signs posted regarding washing your vehicles in the station, please make sure to clean up after yourself.
- The gas meters we are getting from CFI sales, it has been a long and coming this however, because we requested something out of the ordinary, we are paying for it.
- PESH (a division of OSHA) has made some changes and we are going to have to have some training to get up to date with their requirements. I will be meeting with a consultant to let us know what we are lacking so we can pass the audit.
- Ray will be taking care the annual open house this year
- There are only 7 people allowed on the Rescue. There are 5 seat belts in the back and 2 in the front.

1st Assistant Chief:

- I attend the county chief's meeting last Thursday. There was NYSEG rep present and they explained the reason for us responding to calls with them.
- The county has hired an engineer to check the radio systems within the county.
- February 22, there a new law going into effect called Amanda's Law. It states that any residential structure needs a minimum of 1 Carbon Monoxide detector in the residence.
- Coming soon we will have the ability to check sex offender background for new members
- Regarding FAST, there has been a State change stating the minimum number is 6
- We are going to have a new form regarding any type of fires within a structure. It has to be filled out and the Town needs to be notified.

Air/Cascade:

- 3 cascade bottles went out for hydro, they are back.
- Flow tests are done for all the SCBA's this year. HUD's are all fixed as well.
- Fit testing will be scheduled soon. We are waiting to hear back from MES
- There are two more SCBA's in compartment L-2 on the Rescue
- Please take a pack off the tanker if you need one for training purpose.

EMS:

- AED replacement, we have begun the 2 step process of replacing them.

- We did a CPR/AED course back in January. We had a very good turnout of membership. We are going to hold another cardiac class on Thursday February 18th at Station 1. It will be posted. It is a BLS level course.
- I was also asked to look into the possibility to reinstate a policy we had before regarding a personal health data sheet for members. It will have to be voluntary to fill out. It would be a sealed envelope only open in the event of an emergency.
- Saturday April 17th, UHS is holding their annual training.
- We had a cardic arrest call on Monday, Thank you to those who went. I would like to encourage anyone to respond to Echo priority calls if you have CPR training.
- Thank you to Graupman for responding to calls during the day.
- We have just implemented, Condition Red, which would be an "all call" for EMS providers to stand-by in stations to wait for orders. This will only be done in a large emergency.

Training:

- Castle Creek has a boater safety course coming up. The cost will be \$45 that you would have to pay.
- Campville Fire is holding their annual cold water rescue on March 6th.
