The officers had a meeting with Maine regarding doing ladder testing and hose testing together with together. Chris Hoyt has promised them that we will be keeping our air bags this year, so they will not purchase any this year. If the officers agree, we will not upgrade our Genesis this year.

Taxes were done, but we have not had our audit yet. Charlie Barrett, Bill Fenwick in Johnson City, and Ken Lass in downtown Endicott are CPAs who might do audits for nonprofits. Bill will check with Alice.

Town of Union check came and it appears to be the correct amount. Our insurance appears to be slightly less than expected. There is about a \$400 dollar difference. The only thing that we changed was that we knocked down Engine 1 to about \$50,000 rather than replacement. If this is sold our cost will go down, but when we get the land at Station 2 it will go up.

We might be paying too much for Workers Comp, which Chris H. is looking into.

Our lawyer has the paperwork regarding the land deal, but that is all we know at the moment.

Discussion regarding Auxiliary operations in conjunction with Maine Fire. It is possible that our auxiliary would be available to help them with auxiliary functions and vise versa. This will be up to the Auxiliary. Chicken barbecue at Maine is March 24th at 11 a.m.

Rack for Station 2 has been ordered and is ready to be shipped. They will not ship to a residence or the fire station; Mark H. will try to arrange to have the rack shipped to his work address.
